"Fifth-generation warfare (5GW) is warfare that is conducted primarily through non-kinetic military action, such as social engineering, misinformation, cyber attacks, along with emerging technologies such as artificial intelligence and fully autonomous systems."

The word fifth generation war was first used in 2003. As Daniel H. Abbott mentions in his book:

"The term 'fifth-generation warfare' was first used in 2003 by Robert Steele. The following year, Lind criticized the concept, arguing that the fourth generation had yet to fully materialize."

The enemy achieves his goal through his small post. Using the same method, the enemy uses it as his tool to incite the people against the state institutions.

For example, "News European Parliament" is a website whose name is such that the reader immediately thinks that it is a news agency in Europe. In October 2019, the site appears to be the European Parliament's information service. But when its "EU Disinfo Lab" researches, it becomes clear that it is being used from India and most of the material written in it is being used against Pakistan and in favor of Modi government. Interestingly, for example, EP Today's content has been shared in the past by Dr. Prameela Srivastava (head of the Srivastava Group and publisher of the New Delhi Times newspaper). Religious sectarianism in Pakistan on the same website. This news was spread to give air to.

According to "EU Disinfo Lab":

"To understand what was lying beneath this news content, we performed a



content analysis of the op-ed articles and all of EP Today's original content. In doing so, we found that much of EP Today's original content related to topical issues in India and promoted India's interests. We also noticed the reoccurrence of some names who had authored articles related to the Modi government's interests, long-term Indian geopolitical interests and/or were critical towards Pakistan."

That is to say, critical articles about the Modi government's interests, Indian geopolitical interests and Pakistan are written on this website. And naive Pakistanis as well as liberals do not spare any effort in spreading these news which spreads chaos in the country.

Social and Political Disorder:

Enemy states use it to try to deactivate other states. It exaggerates locally small incidents and is widely publicized. There is an attempt to deactivate the state and state institutions by interfering directly or indirectly in religious protests, anti-opposition movements, public demonstrations and other events. It is inculcated in the minds of the people that their rights are being taken away and the people are brought to the streets to cry for the exploitation of their rights. The main purpose of which is to create hatred among the people against the state institutions and to make the state inactive.

According to EU Disinfo Lab:

- "There is arguably a pattern here:
- Stylistically and thematically similar demonstrations to discredit Pakistan;
- Held at the same time as UN Human Rights Council sessions;

• Complemented by Times of Geneva side-line interviews on the demonstrations with the same reoccurring figures."

That is to say, the Times of Geneva interviews were repeated with the aforementioned figures. The content of the interviews focused on the unfair treatment of minorities in Pakistan, the problems of Balochistan and the Ahmadiyya Mirzais and supported the causes of various protests, under which Pakistan has always been the target of criticism.

* Destruction of the economy

In this regard, the vested interests in the state institutions and the priests of lust for money are being used to delay projects of national interest, to invest in non-profit projects and to reduce the budget so that the country's economy is destroyed and The country began to depend on the world powers and global economic institutions, which led to the country becoming indebted and falling into the mire of inflation, poverty and destitution. In this regard, "4 News Agency" is very active which is active in damaging the reputation of Pakistan like "News European Parliament" and "Times of Geneva's".

* Conquering the institutions of enemy countries

In this, the state tries its best to make its defense invincible and the enemy state's defense institutions invincible. Trying to gain access so that the enemy has to suffer losses and their secrets are revealed. According to a Dawn News report:

"The Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR) on Wednesday 12 August 2020 said that Pakistan's intelligence agencies had identified a major cyber-attack by Indian intelligence agencies, targeting the mobile phones and gadgets of government officials and military personnel. In a statement, the military's media affairs wing said that the cyber-attack involved a range of cyber-crimes, including deceitful fabrication, by hacking the personal mobiles and technical gadgets of government officials and military personnel."²

All of the above were different strategies of the Fifth Generation Warfare. In this regard, it is necessary to look at the role of teachers.

Give glad tidings to the people and do not hate them and make things easy for them and do not make things difficult for them."

Giving good news is a positive thought and making it easy is a positive action. On the contrary, creating hatred is a negative thought and creating problems is a negative action.

"Indeed, good thinking is one of the best acts of worship."5

Anger, enmity, prejudice, hatred, condition, envy, jealousy, jealousy, etc. are all negative emotions which are absolutely forbidden in Islam. They are strictly forbidden and on the contrary, there are positive emotions such as love, peace, cleanliness, self-sacrifice,

(It is enough for a man to narrate every hearsay (without investigation) in order to be a sinner.)

We have to think about the extent to which the Muslim Ummah has moved on social media. According to a December 2019 report by EU Disinfo Lab (NGO), Pakistan's neighbor India is at the forefront of this campaign against Pakistan. According to this report from India, anti-Pakistan websites are being used. So that they can inactivate the state by creating religious, political and social chaos among the people through them and they can insult the state institutions.

Teachers need to not only give positive thinking to the students in view of the negative activities of their rival country but also enable them not to be a part of the propaganda of hostile elements and their country and nation. Develop a strategy against the elements that are harming the enemy so that the enemy is always trying to save himself. Proposals:

- 1) In this regard, the teachers have to play their role in shaping the character of the children and make them thinkers and seekers of truth in the light of Qur'an and Hadith. Because in this tempting age, anti-national forces are using social media to mislead the young generation and the young generation is unable to recognize their macro deception.
- 2) It is the job of the teachers to make themselves effective first in the world of technology and then to provide guidance to their students in this regard so that the enemy can be answered in his language.
- 3) In this regard, the government of the day should expose the nefarious intentions of the hostile countries and with the help of teachers, curriculum development wing and higher education commission of Pakistan, bring these negative efforts to light in book form and Should be made a part of compulsory subjects from secondary level to university students. Because this age is very important for children's character building. This book should be published every year with additions and modifications. So that the younger generation will be aware of the enemy's intentions.
